

NORTH MONTCO TECHNICAL CAREER CENTER COSMETOLOGY

The Cosmetology Program covers instruction in Cosmetology (hair care), Esthetics (skin care and make-up), Nail Technology, and Salon Management. Students must complete 1250 hours of instruction with at least a 75% average before they are eligible to take the State Board of Cosmetology license examination.

The Full-Time Cosmetology program is offered to 10th, 11th and 12th grade students in Cosmetology. Full-time Cosmetology students take their academic classes at NMTCC. Academic classes are integrated in nature, combining essential academic skills with those of the workplace. Upon successful completion of the hour requirements, students are able to take their state boards examination. At this time, students can also choose to leave school on days they do not have academics for hands-on, paid work experience.
