- exhibits friendly attitude
- completes work with accuracy and attention to detail
- strives to improve academic weaknesses
- studies on a daily basis
- scores well on tests consistently
- attends class daily

- brings all necessary materials to class plus additional aides (i.e. highlighters)
- organizes and maintains materials neatly
- hands in assignments before the due date
